

SOMETHING NEW FROM SOMETHING OLD

In September of 1997, the Hastings/Quinte/ Land O' Lakes Recreation Trails Steering Committee was formed as a vehicle for bringing together people and groups who had interest in developing a regional trails network. Representatives were from area Municipalities, various trail groups, Chambers of Commerce, Conservation Authorities and individuals. This umbrella group was renamed the **EASTERN ONTARIO TRAILS ALLIANCE** in the spring of 1998.

The primary focus of the Alliance was the abandoned rail lines and some forest access roads in Hastings, Northumberland, Southeast Peterborough, Lennox and Addington, Frontenac and Lanark counties.

Thanks to funding sources and partners, the Alliance has created an overall strategic Master Plan, a management plan for the operations, development, maintenance and marketing of the trails network.

To date, EOTA has been able to deck and rail bridges, Install signage, gravel and grade trails, install culverts, trim brush and open and maintain hundreds of kilometers of trails.

EOTA OBJECTIVES & GUIDELINES

Objectives:

- The preservation of the continuity of the corridors for Tourism and other economic uses.
- The management of the corridors as a shared facility representing the interest of recreation users, adjoining landowners and other interested groups.
- The development of the corridors as a recreational attraction contributing to the tourism and economy of the eastern Ontario region.
- The preservation and enhancement of natural and human heritage along the corridors.

Guidelines for Trail Use:

- No entry without Trail Pass or OFSC Trail Permit
- No entry without pass from EOTA for motorized vehicles
- Use at own risk
- Stay on the trail and obey all signs
- Be courteous to all users
- Keep to the right side and yield to the other users
- Licence and Insurance required for ALL motorized vehicles
- No hunting
- Keep dogs on a leash at all times while on the trail
- If you bring it in, take it out!
- No overnight camping
- Respect the integrity of the trail
